Prelude

## \*CALL TO WORSHIP from Psalm 116

L: I love the Lord, because He has heard my voice and my supplications. Because He inclined his ear to me, therefore I will call on Him as long as I live.

**P: The snares of death encompassed me. I suffered distress and anguish. Then I called on the name of the Lord.**
